Course Concept:

The [Germanic-American Institute](http://www.gai-mn.org) will offer a group class to meet the language needs of your organization. Group lessons will be based on acquiring a conversational proficiency as well as cultural competency for business and travel purposes. Group work and partner exercises in addition to traditional teaching methods will be incorporated into the curriculum. Participants will have opportunities during each class to practice and improve their acquired language skills.

The instructor for this course will be a native speaker with experience teaching German as a foreign language in classroom and corporate settings.
