Overview:

The Germanic-American Institute is a Minnesota non-profit, located on historic Summit Avenue in St. Paul. Our mission focuses on promoting German language and culture.

The Germanic-American Institute in St. Paul, Minnesota is accepting applications for **German Instructors** for adult language classes and Samstagsschule.

Hours: The positions average 2 classes / week with each adult class lasting 2.5 hours – Most classes are scheduled weekday evenings. Samstagsschule for kids & teens is scheduled on Saturday mornings

The ideal candidate for this job is passionate about German language education and has experience with teaching German.

The GAI will offer 18 adult classes for beginners to nearly-fluent students along with Samstagsschule for kids and teens. Adult students range from working professionals to retirees, to the occasional high school student, with many different reasons for learning German. Children range in age from 4 years to middle school / high school with varying levels of German knowledge.

As a non-accredited institution, we do not assign grades for our courses and try to limit homework to about 1-2 hours/week. Our core academic curriculum is provided, with the ability to supplement and adjust based on individual preferences.

- Native or near-native fluency in German.
- Professional experience / training teaching German as a foreign language or equivalent.
- Ability to maintain a classroom environment that is conducive to learning.
- Familiarity with a variety of instructional methods, materials, and techniques.
- Availability: Weekday evenings for adult classes and Saturday morning for Samstagsschule

- Graduate degree and/or teaching licensure preferred but not required
